Hima B. is a queer South Asian and an independent writer/director/producer who makes social issue documentaries, narratives, experimental films and videos that explore the intersections of race, gender, sexual orientation, labor, & economics, especially as they impact LGBTQ people and women/girls.

Her primary interest in filmmaking is using non-fictional, fictional, & experimental genres to push the boundaries of form and content by exploring creative ways of telling stories. She hopes to challenge audiences with new information and personal narratives while generating greater awareness around social issues and use the media's potential for education, artistic innovation, & social change.

Hima B. was born in India, raised in the US, & earned her MFA from Mills College (Oakland, CA). She lives and works in NYC and San Francisco. She is also the Education Director at MIX NYC where she coordinates "A Different Take," a video production workshop for LGBTQ youth & adults who are trained in all aspects of video production as they create their own videos.
